Christmas Mass Schedule: As you know, the Fourth Sunday of Advent this year is December 24. With Christmas Eve Masses, the question arises about the number of Masses that a priest may celebrate in any given day. When there is a good reason, our priests have the faculty to celebrate 3 Masses on Sunday and 3 Masses on Holy Days of obligation. A "day" is a 24-hour period, midnight to midnight" (Clergy News Notes November 2017 edition). For this reason Father is limited on the amount of masses he may say during that particular weekend. It is important to note both the 4th Sunday of Advent and Christmas are Holy Days of Obligation, everyone should attend a 4th Sunday of Advent Mass along with a Christmas Mass. Therefore for this year only, the Mass Schedule for that weekend will be as follows:

Saturday, December 23rd

4th Sunday of Advent Mass: 4pm at St. Rose, 5:30pm at St. Louis

Sunday, December 24th

4th Sunday of Advent Mass at **10am** at St. Joseph;

Christmas Eve Mass: 4pm at St. Rose; 6pm at St. Louis

Monday, December 25th

Christmas Day Mass: 9am at St. Joseph.


