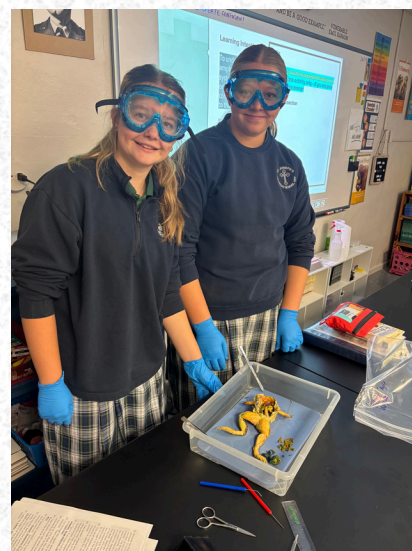
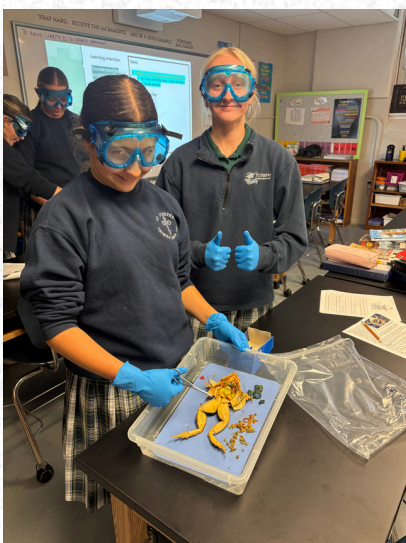
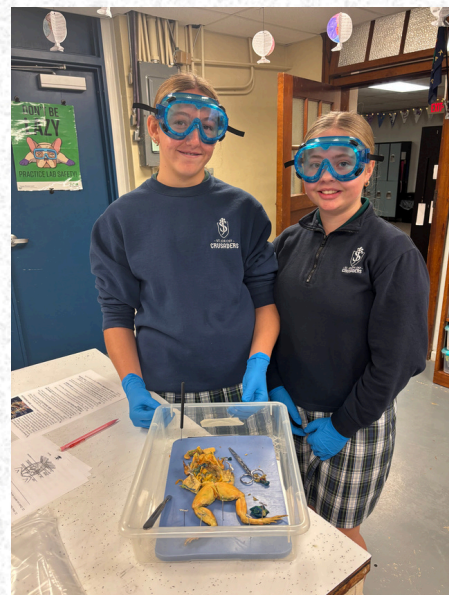

**Colwich Bus Riders:** Sacred Heart Catholic Church will begin renovations to the Parish Hall on **Monday, Nov. 3rd**. The construction workers will use the back parking lot for their vehicles and large items needed for the renovation. Therefore, we will not be able to use the back parking lot of the church to pick up the bus riders or to drop off the bus riders.

After much thought and consideration we have decided to utilize the parking lot of The Keg as our new pick up and drop off location. I am asking that parents park on the west side of the parking lot and face 1st Street. The bus will pull into the parking lot using the entrance off of 1st Street, pick up/drop off, and then exit the parking lot using the south entrance and turn directly onto 53rd. Please do not pull out until the bus has left the parking lot. This will ensure the safety of our students.

We know this is an inconvenience for students who live close enough to Sacred Heart to walk home and for the students who attend Catechesis of the Good Shepherd on Wednesdays. We are asking that you make arrangements to pick your bus rider(s) up at The Keg and get them safely to their destination.

We do not know how long we will utilize this new plan but it will be until the renovations are complete.
